Korea and LAC: an agenda for prosperity through trade and investment

Korea was the first East Asian country to seek Free Trade Agreements with LAC partners in the early 2000s, signing FTA with Chile (2004), Peru (2011), Colombia (2013) and Central America (2018). Trade between the two regions experienced a fast and sustained growth, increasing 9.2% per year on average between 2000 and 2018, while Korean investment in the region has expanded sixfold in the last decade alone. This panel will discuss the strategic alliance between Korea and LAC and how to optimize the effect of the FTAs based on the experiences of entrepreneurs and high-level officials from both regions.

Investment in Infrastructure Services and PPPs for improving lives

Latin American and Caribbean countries are actively pursuing to invest in construction, upgrade and maintenance of public infrastructure for economic and social growth and improve public services. In 2018, the LAC region attracted the world's second highest investment in infrastructure from the private sector, which accounts for 16% of the global investment. Unlocking the potential of the 4th Industrial Revolution in LAC

The advent of the 4th Industrial Revolution is changing how we live. Additionally, E-commerce or the Digital Economy, is enabling entrepreneurs to reach a broader network of customers and access to global value chains. This is especially impactful in LAC as it has one of the highest internet penetration rates in the world, climbing from less than 5% being online in 2000 to 55% in 2017. In this regard, Korea is the first country with 5G phone on the market and keeps promoting laws, systems, and policy reforms so that this new phenomenon becomes a new economic growth engine. Along the same line, LAC should strive to upgrade its regulatory environment, human capital development, and industrial structure. and innovations that can grow our economies, educate our people, and improve the quality of life for everyone.
